A continuación va a realizar una prueba que contiene **dos ejercicios de Comprensión Oral**.

Los ejercicios de **Comprensión Oral** tienen una estructura similar: se reproduce una grabación y a partir de ella se hacen una serie de preguntas.

Cuando le indiquen que puede empezar, dispondrá de 4 minutos para leer las preguntas antes de comenzar a escuchar el primer ejercicio. Escuchará el primer ejercicio tres veces, con una breve pausa entre cada repetición. Después dispondrá de 2 minutos para leer, o releer, las preguntas del segundo ejercicio. Escuchará el segundo ejercicio tres veces, con una breve pausa entre cada repetición.

Dispondrá de unos minutos para revisar sus respuestas y asegurarse de haber respondido en la **HOJA DE RESPUESTAS**.

Las tareas o preguntas serán del siguiente tipo:

- **Preguntas o frases incompletas**, seguidas de una serie de respuestas posibles o de frases que las completan. En este caso deberá **elegir la respuesta correcta** rodeando con un círculo la letra de su opción en la **HOJA DE RESPUESTAS**. Sólo una de las opciones es correcta.

- **Frases para completar con una o más palabras o números**. En este caso deberá **escribir las palabras o números** en el espacio correspondiente en la **HOJA DE RESPUESTAS**. Puede escribir los números en cifra o en letra.

EJERCICIO 1: Bad habits

Jackie: For this week's podcasts in english.com we're talking about habits, bad habits. [Richard laughs] Now Richard, you have some bad habits.

Richard: Yes. I think my worst bad habit is **biting my nails (1A)**.

Jackie: When do you bite your nails?

Richard: I don't know. Suddenly, I realize I'm biting my nails and I can't stop.

Jackie: I know. It's when you're reading and when you're **watching TV (2A)**.

Richard: Mmm probably. I try to stop. I try to think that I shouldn't bite my nails but I just can't stop. What about you though, Jackie? You must have some bad habits.

Jackie: Yes, of course. I think my worst bad habit is **I spend too long on the computer (3C)**.

Richard: Mmm I think one of mine as well, yes.

Jackie: **I work on the computer**, so that's... that's okay, but it's like... **but it's just before I go to bed (4C)** I think I'm going to check my emails and then half an hour later, one hour later, I'm still on the computer. I'm not working and I really, really want to go to bed so it's a very bad habit.

Richard: You just can't stop yourself.

Jackie: No. Another one for you, Richard?

Richard: Yes. I think **I eat too quickly (5C)**.

Jackie: You do eat too quickly [laughs]

Richard: I always finish **my meals way ahead of you (6B)**. So I've finished and you're still eating.

Jackie: Yeah, you always finish before me.

Richard: **It can't be healthy (7C)**, I'm sure.

Jackie: No, I don't think... it's... it's not good for you, Richard.

Richard: I should slow down.

Jackie: Slow down [laughs].

Richard: And another one from you?

Jackie: I have to say that unfortunately **I'm rather untidy (8B)**. And I'm not very good at cleaning up after me like in the kitchen, for example. When I'm cooking, I don't do the washing up, and then I start to cook something else and the whole kitchen is in a complete mess.

Richard: Yes, well **neither of us like doing the washing up (9C)**, do we?

Jackie: No. But in general, I... **I have to make a big effort to tidy my clothes away (10B)**, tidy my books away...

Richard: Tidy the study.

Jackie: [laughs] It's a very bad habit. But, er,... well, we should try to change, Richard.

EJERCICIO 2: TRAVELLING ABROAD

A. Good morning. This is an announcement for all passengers travelling on the 9:25 flight **TOM1223** (1) to Rome. This flight is delayed by two hours because of **bad weather** (2).

B. Would all passengers travelling to Tokyo on flight FR3421 please have your boarding passes and **passports** (3) ready for boarding. Flight FR3421 now boarding at gate **21** (4).

C. This is the final boarding call for passengers Gemma and Ryan Grey flying to Athens on flight EZ9753. Your flight is ready to **leave** (5). Please go to gate **14** immediately. The doors of the plane will close in **five minutes** (6). Final boarding call for passengers Gemma and Ryan Grey.

D. This is an announcement for passengers travelling to Amsterdam on flight **KL1050** (7). Will all passengers with express boarding tickets and passengers travelling with **young children** (8) please go to gate 6 for boarding. That's all passengers with express boarding tickets and passengers travelling with young children go to gate 6 for boarding. Thank you.

E. Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. We have landed at JFK Airport in New York where the local time is **18:30** (9) and the temperature is **76°** (10). We hope you have enjoyed your flight with American Airlines this evening and wish you a very safe journey to your final destination.
