TRANSCRIPT

THE GOOGLE SCIENCE FAIR

The Google Science Fair is an annual international online science competition for people aged 13 to 18. It is sponsored by *Google*, *Lego*, *Virgin Galactic*, *National Geographic* and *Scientific American*.

If you want to participate in the competition, you must formulate a hypothesis, do an experiment and present your results online. Your entry must have 10 sections, including a summary, an “about me” page and a detailed description of your project. It must be in English, German, Italian, Spanish or French. And you must also have a Google account.

Each project is judged on eight fundamental criteria. These include hypothesis, research, experiment, presentation, data, observation and conclusion. One winner gets the grand prize – a *National Geographic* trip to the Galapagos Islands and a \$50,000 scholarship. Last year, American student Olivia Hallisey, 16, won the grand prize for creating the Ebola Assay Card. This can detect Ebola viral antigens in under 30 minutes.

Google is proof that students can change the world. Two students, Larry Page and Sergey Brin, created Google as a research project at Stanford University in 1986. Google is now valued at almost \$400 billion!



JANE GOODALL, A SCIENTIST AND ANIMAL LOVER TALKS ABOUT HER LIFE

Jane Goodall My name is Jane Goodall, my age is 80. My job is giving people hope. I learned from my mother so much the importance, I think, of support. Because when I was a child my mother supported all my crazy love of animals. When I wanted to go off to Africa, aged 10, and everybody laughed at me, she supported me and she simply said, which I took to heart and repeat again and again, that if you really want something you have to be prepared to work very hard, take advantage of opportunity, and above all never give up.

Education is not the sort of education that we think about when children go to school. I think education is learning from experience. I think we continue to be educated through out life. And I think everyday brings its own kind of education, and we can learn from it if we keep our eyes open, our ears open, and think of everyday as an adventure, then each day will give us a lesson.

I have many kinds of happiness. I'm completely happy when I'm alone in nature. I love to be alone in nature, makes me very happy. I'm really happy when I sit around with friends in the evening, particularly around a camp fire, we can tell stories, drink a bit of red wine. I'm totally happy when I'm walking with a dog because dogs make me really, really happy, because you can just be yourself with a dog, and a dog is always him or herself with me. And when I was a child, my great teacher was a dog. The dog who taught me we are just part of the animal kingdom. And that we are not the only beings with personalities and minds capable of reasoning, and certainly not the only beings with emotions like happiness, sadness, fear, despair nor are we the only beings capable of giving and receiving love.
