NATIONAL PARKS OF THE WORLD

Some of the most beautiful national parks to visit in 2021

TEXT 0Göreme National Park, Turkey

Prepare to look at volcanic landscapes situated in a UNESCO World Heritage Site at Göreme National Park in Turkey. Walk the high hills, explore nearby villages and observe fantastic multi-colored mountains.

TEXT 1Nahuel Huapi National Park, Argentina

The oldest national park in Argentina, Nahuel, was created in 1934. The park has two zones: the park itself and the natural reserve. It also has geological formations and rivers to swim in summer.

TEXT 2Arcipelago di La Maddalena National Park, Italy

In northern Sardinia, you will find this park, which covers 180km² of coast and has more than 60 islands, both large and small. There are plenty of boat tours to discover these scenic islands during your visit.

TEXT 3Fuji Hakone Izu National Park, Japan

Home to Mt Fuji, the symbol of Japan, this park is one of Japan's most famous landmarks. While Mt Fuji is the primary attraction, the mountain is surrounded by many other beautiful locations to visit.

TEXT 4Lençóis Maranhenses National Park, Brazil

If you're looking for real beauty this is your park. White sand dunes reflect on wonderful blue lakes to create scenery that is simply out of this world. Take impressive Instagram pictures that will surprise your friends.

TEXT 5Bromo Tengger Semeru National Park, Indonesia

Known as the "land of sand and fire", this park covers 800km² and is the largest volcanic region in its province. A visit provides the chance to see lava coming from Mount Semeru, which is an active volcano 3,676 meters above sea level.

TEXT 6Jostedalsgreen National Park, Norway

This park is located in Norway, and is placed between two of the world's largest fjords and has the largest glacier on the European mainland. A trip here also offers museums to discover, as well as wonderful mountainous scenery.

Most tourists in Lanzarote think about a typical Spanish beach holiday. But Timanfaya allows visitors to enjoy the glory of fantastic landscapes. Apart from this, it's the only geological national park in Spain.

HOW READING ENGLISH ONLINE WILL HELP YOU LEARN ENGLISH

*Reading online has many benefits and
will help you learn lots of interesting things*

Online reading is:

- **Portable:** That means you can take it anywhere! If you have a device that connects to the internet, and an internet connection, you can read (no need to carry around a heavy book or a large magazine).
- **Always updating:** When you finish a book, you have to get a new one. When you finish an online article, you can just wait a day or so for more articles to be published.
- **Well-written:** Not everything online is written in difficult colloquial English. Many websites have great writers to make sure you're reading the best quality English.
- **Easy to understand:** Everyone can read online articles and blogs because the language is usually easy to understand.
- **Fun:** There's a website for everything! You're sure to find something that you find interesting. All you need now is to choose a website—or a few websites—to learn from. Before you go exploring online, it's important to understand how these websites can teach you English reading skills. There are a few different kinds of websites that can help you practice reading English. Blogs are more informal websites with writing on them. They're often personal and in them, the writer shares their experiences or thoughts with their readers. Some websites are more like online magazines, which publish longer articles about certain topics. Others are news websites, which usually have shorter articles about current events (things that are happening now). All these websites can help you learn if you use them the right way.

Once you choose the perfect website, think of these two great ideas for learning with online content:

- **Read the comments:** When you finish reading the article, scroll down to the comments (if there are any). Comments are not always useful, but sometimes they can add more information or another point of view to what you just read about. Add your own comment, and join the discussion.
- **Click on relevant links:** If you find an interesting link in the article, click and move on to the next article. This will keep you reading and learning. If you don't want to get distracted while reading the article, open all new links in new tabs (right-click on the link and choose "open link in new tab").

***HOW TO SAVE TIME IN THE MORNING***

Tips to get ready for work more quickly

A recent [0] says the average American spends approximately five hours a week getting ready for work. This is time that would be better spent in bed. Preparing in advance for the morning can save you that sleep and it also gets you to work on time. Here [17] some advice to help you.

Shower at night. This will eliminate one of your [18] morning rituals. However, some people might look best if they shower in the morning.

Pick out your clothes in advance. Watch the [19] forecast to see what clothes would be appropriate. If you're really ambitious, use the weekly forecast to pick out your clothes for the [20] week.

Set up the coffee machine. If your coffee machine is fully automated, you can [21] it with coffee and water and set it to begin shortly after your alarm goes off.

Pack your lunch. Eating out [22] lunchtime won't require any preparation. But if you want a light meal, save time in the morning by packing your lunch the night before. If you have leftovers, packing some away in a small container for lunch is an easy [23] to prepare.

Have accessories packed and in a designated location. If you bring a bag to work [24] morning, pack it the night before. If you think you will need a coat, umbrella or hat, keep them in the same location, preferably [25] the door so that you can take them all as you leave.
