# ST 3: PLANS FOR THE WEEKEND

### Instructions for the candidate:

### **Instructions for the examiner:**

You work for a company. There is a long holiday coming (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and you have no plans. Ask your workmate whether s/he would like to do something with you.

Choose the items from the list that best correspond to what the candidate says in each moment. **It is not necessary to use all the questions and the order is not fixed**. The task finishes when the allotted time is up.

- Greet the candidate and start the conversation.
- Elicit the following information:
  - Are you doing anything this long weekend?
  - What would you like to do? The long weekend starts on Friday.
  - The weather is going to be good.
  - How about going to the mountains/ to the beach, etc.?
  - How much money can you afford/spend?
  - Where shall we stay? Why don't we go camping?
  - What equipment/clothes shall we take?
  - How would you like to travel by car, train, coach, plane etc.?

Finish the conversation in a suitable way. Suggestion: We'll have a great weekend.

# Instructions for the candidate:

  - What are you going to visit?
  - How much money did you bring with you?
  - Do you plan to buy anything?


