- Why you recommend it and why it is especially good to learn English.

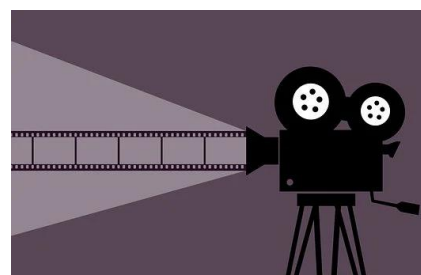
