INSTRUCCIONES PARA 2 PERSONAS CANDIDATAS

- Este prueba consta de dos tareas:
 - En la Tarea 1 tendrás que producir un monólogo en base a unas directrices relacionadas con un tema. Deberás hablar entre unos 3 y 4 minutos.
 - En la Tarea 2 tendrás que intervenir en una conversación sobre un tema concreto con tu compañero/a. Deberá durar alrededor de unos 5 minutos.
- Duración máxima: 30 minutos, a distribuir en dos fases:
 - Preparación: 15 minutos como máximo para preparar ambas tareas siguiendo las indicaciones de una tarjeta que facilitará el profesorado-examinador. No podrás comunicarte con tu compañero/a durante esta fase.
 - Realización: 15 minutos como máximo para llevar a cabo ambas tareas.
- Se te facilitará papel en blanco para que puedas tomar notas que te ayuden durante tu exposición y diálogo. No escribas frases completas sino ideas o conceptos, estructuras sintácticas, palabras o expresiones concretas, etc.
- Recuerda que debes utilizar estructuras gramaticales, léxicas y funcionales propias del nivel ya que lo que importa no es tanto lo que dices sino cómo lo dices.

SPORT

You are going to talk about the topic of sports. Express your ideas and use arguments to justify your opinion. Use the following statements to help you prepare your monologue:

1. **Talk about** your favourite sport when you were a child: when, where and how you started doing it, how often you did it and whether you are still keen on it now.
2. **Talk about** your favourite sports to watch on TV and why you prefer those rather than others.
3. **Talk about** your favourite sportsperson at the moment, mentioning why.

2. **Talk about** the aspects that you liked the most and the least about your old school. What would you change, if you could?
3. **Tell us a funny anecdote** that happened to you at school with your classmates.

HEALTH AND FITNESS

1. **Describe** your favourite physical activity nowadays: how long you have been doing it, where, when and how often you do it, and the benefits it has for your physical and mental health.
2. **Talk about** any changes you have made to your physical activity, diet and sleep in recent years. Have you noticed an improvement? Explain.
3. **Describe** how different people in your family try to keep fit.

2. **Talk about** your favourite holiday destination abroad. **Describe** the aspects you particularly value about that country, as well as the ones that you don't like so much.
3. **Tell us an anecdote** about an unforgettable trip.

2. **Discuss** whether you think people read more or less now than in the past, justifying your answer.
3. **Talk about** your favourite book when you were a child and the memories attached to it.

5. **Talk about** the most popular free time activities for young people or elderly people (CHOOSE ONE) in your town, including some details and the benefits those activities have for that sector of the population.
6. **Discuss** an ideal free time activity that you would like to do if you could, and why.

3. **Give a few pieces of advice** to people who may be looking for a job right now.

2. **Talk about** what you like to do with different members of your family, specifying when, where and why.
3. **Tell us an anecdote** involving an unforgettable moment you have experienced as a family.

You are going to talk about the topic of your childhood. Express your ideas and use arguments to justify your opinion. Use the following statements to prepare your monologue:

2. **Describe** a special friend you had, what he/she was like and what you both used to do together.
3. **Tell an anecdote** you lived with him/her that you like to remember.


TARJETA 7B TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN


TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN


TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN

2. **Describe** what happened on that day. Give details of what you did.
3. **Explain** why it was so special for you and why you keep a special memory of it.
