#### STAY SAFE: Essential Equipment when riding a scooter

Whatever skill level you're at, it's important to stay safe while using your scooter. To help avoid injuries, you'll need the following safety equipment.

#### HELMET

This should have the correct size and fit the head comfortably.

#### **LIGHTS**

At night, lights can help you keep visible when scooting around. Most bike lights will be able to fit around scooter handlebars.

#### **PROTECTIVE GLOVES**

If you're going to use your scooter for a long period, gloves can help prevent grazes and keep out the cold. They need to be flexible, so cycling gloves should do the job.

#### WHERE CAN I RIDE

- PRIVATE LAND: As long as you have permission, you can ride anywhere you want on private land. This could be your own garden, or your friends'!
- **CYCLE LANES AND SKATE PARKS**: They aren't just for bikes or skateboards, you know!
- PUBLIC PARKS: You can ride in most parks, but always check beforehand. Some locations ban scooters, bikes and skateboards.

#### **KNEE PADS**

These keep you protected in case of any nasty falls; after all, tricks don't always go right on the first attempt!

#### **ELBOW PADS**

Properly fitted elbow pads help prevent any unnecessary scrapes or bruises.

#### WHERE CAN'T I RIDE

**ROADS:** Not only is riding a scooter on the

road illegal, it's also unsafe.

**CROWDED AREAS:** Don't ride in areas that are too busy to prevent collisions and

accidents.

**PUBLIC FOOTPATHS:** Don't upset pedestrians and ride somewhere else.
