TASK ONE (5 points)

Instructions of the task:

This year, your school is involved in a cross-curricular project to raise awareness on animal protection. Soon it will host an exhibition on the issue.

In your last class, your English teacher talked about how animals react to music and he has asked the class to do some research on the internet about animals and music to contribute to the upcoming exhibition.

You found the following extract about elephants and music. Read it and write a short text summarizing the most relevant information, simplifying what you read. Avoid repetitions, do not use the exact same expressions and sentences from the text in your summary. The text has to be 40-50 words.

Elephants are already known for their ability to paint with their trunks, but it turns out that they might be musically inclined as well (there is a viral video of elephants swaying their trunks to violin music!). In northern Thailand, a conservationist named Richard Lair put together the Thai Elephant Orchestra, in which 16 elephants play specially developed instruments like steel drums and even harmonicas. Neuroscientists who have studied the music of the Thai Elephant Orchestra have determined that the animals are able to keep a very stable tempo on a large drum— even more stable than a human can.




