5. Create strong passwords with a combination of letters, numbers, and symbols.
6. Check your bank account frequently and keep a record of your activity.
7. Don't click on links or download attachments from emails that make you doubt.

## First Aid Tips

- 1 Sunburn**  
Apply aloe cream to the damaged skin a few times during the day.
- 2 Treat a cut**  
Wash your hands with soap and water. Stop the bleeding by pressing the cut with a clean cloth.
- 3 A broken bone**  
Keep the leg or arm in an elevated position and apply some ice. Call the doctor.
- 4 A headache**  
Put a cold, wet cloth on the forehead and let the child rest in a dark, quiet room.
- 5 A fever**  
Apply a cool, wet cloth on the child's forehead to lower the temperature. Dress the child in light clothes.
