*MyStore* is especially important as it saves and stores all of your documents online so that your work is safe if your laptop stops working. You can also work offline and collaborate on a document with your classmates.

Have you ever wondered how great it would be if you had an assistant who would type everything you are saying out aloud? Well you do! And her name is *DinoDictation*. Just start talking into *DinoDictation* and it'll convert everything for you digitally which you can paste into other apps, send as an email message or save it for later. It's available for different languages and different accents, too.

Do you ever feel that days fly when you're in your final term and you just don't know how to get organized? This is where the *Planme* app is useful. Create mind maps to help you organize your thoughts, remember things and generate new ideas, and it also includes a calendar.

Did you miss a class and need pictures of the notes or of the whiteboard? *Supereye* takes pictures of documents, whiteboards, blackboards, magazines and more and converts them into editable, shareable text. It can read images even from an angle and cleans up shadows, too. Studying was never easier, or more fun!
