

## **Informació sobre la prova de mediació oral**

Els candidats faran aquesta prova en grups de **tres persones** davant d'un tribunal compost per **dos examinadors**.

La prova té **diverses parts**:

### **Introducció**

Els candidats es presenten i parlen d'ells mateixos durant **1** minut cadascun.

Abans de la prova, cadascun dels tres candidats rebrà un text diferent, al voltant d'un mateix tema, i tindrà **7-8** minuts per preparar-lo. Els candidats hauran de transmetre la informació continguda en el text als altres candidats per resoldre una situació comunicativa i arribar a un acord. **(8-10** minuts)

*No es podrà escriure res sobre el text. Es podran, però, escriure 4 o 5 paraules clau en un full a part.*

## **Informació sobre la prova d'expressió i interacció oral**

**Primera part:** narració (**1** minut per candidat)

Cada candidat ha de relatar als altres candidats una experiència, pròpia o d'altri, relacionada amb el tema de la prova de Mediació oral.

**Segona part:** conversa (aproximadament **15** minuts)

Els tres candidats han d'intercanviar els seus punts de vista i han de discutir en grup a partir de les idees punts que se'ls suggereix en relació amb el tema. (No caldrà tractar tots els punts proposats.)

Els candidats han de prendre i cedir la paraula alternativament, i cap d'ells no pot monopolitzar la conversa.

### **Avaluació**

S'avaluaran la qualitat de l'exposició individual, la capacitat d'argumentació, de selecció i transmissió d'informació i de participació en la conversa. Els examinadors també avaluaran la competència gramatical, l'ús del lèxic i la pronúncia (pronunciació, ritme i entonació).

En cap cas no es tindran en compte les opinions dels candidats.

**Durada total aproximada de les proves: 30** minuts

**Part 1.**

Relate a past experience you or somebody you know may have had connected with the oral mediation texts. You should speak for approximately one minute.

**Part 2.**

You should now have a discussion with your fellow examinees based on the guidelines below. You are expected to exchange opinions and give good reasons for them. To do this task, you may use all the guidelines or just those necessary.

The discussion should last approximately 15 minutes.

1. Every day we make choices about what we eat and how we live. Now we ask ourselves, "Should we be buying organic food?"
2. Prices, safety, convenience or taste - what's your biggest priority when you're doing your weekly shopping?
3. "Food security is the responsibility of us all, whether it's Government, industry or consumers."
4. Discuss the pros and cons of becoming a vegetarian.
5. Do you think certain food should be banned? Why? Why not?
