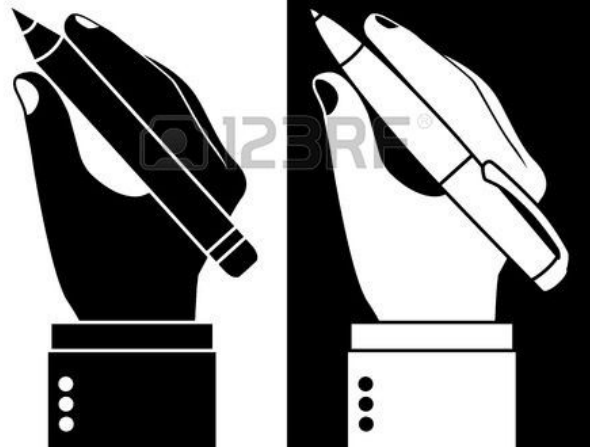

- not putting off work for later, *etc...*

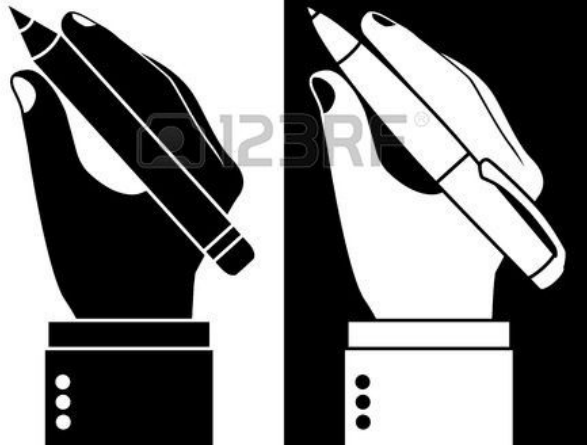
