TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN

INCLUSIVE LANGUAGE AND EQUALITY

You are going to talk about inclusive language and equality. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. Why should inclusive language be considered important? Why not?
- 2. Is inclusive language necessarily linked to the idea of equality?
- 3. What should the ordinary citizen do to fight for equality?

- 2. What are the consequences of having such a big amount of content at your disposal?
- 3. How do you consider that TV content has evolved in time?

- 2. What are the advantages and disadvantages of podcasting and digital content?
- 3. What are the consequences of having such a big amount of content at your disposal?

You and your partner have decided to move in together but there are a lot of things to discuss about. Talk with your partner about this by considering the following:

- What type of dwelling you should opt for and why.
- How to share costs such as: housing, food, taxes, bills or healthcare.

You are going to talk about racism. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. Give your opinion about such violence against Asians or black people.
- 2. Racism, fear and intolerance go hand in hand.
- 3. What can we do to eradicate these crimes? What would you do if you were a politician?

FAKE GURUS

The increasing number of fake gurus or coaches who position themselves as being more successful than they are in order to sell their overpriced diets, exercise plans, seminars, courses, etc. is augmenting nowadays. Every week there's a new YouTube Star selling some kind of product.

You are going to talk about fake gurus. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. What are the advantages and disadvantages of following these coaches?
- 2. How have marketing strategies evolved over time?
- 3. Have you ever purchased any product or service offered by a celebrity?

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TAREA DE COPRODUCCIÓN

THE BRIGHT SIDE OF COVID-19

You and your friend are going to analyze the positive effects of COVID-19. Talk with your partner about this by considering the following:

- The positive aspects of lockdown concerning the opportunity to rethink one's life priorities, appreciate freedom, a new perspective on work, career, social relations, lifestyle, etc.
- Environmental benefits (restoring biodiversity; improving water and air quality; less noise pollution; slowing down resource consumption).

SCAMS

According to The Guardian, a new fraud starts with a text about a fee for a parcel and can end with criminals emptying your bank account.

You are going to talk about scams and frauds. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. What are the risks of identity theft and the rest of cybercrimes?
- 2. How could we avoid cybercrime?
- 3. What would you advise a person who fears using new technologies to do?

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TARJETA 4A

TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN

AVOIDING PHYSICAL CLOSENESS

According to a guide to post-lockdown greetings published online, if you are not mentally prepared to hug your neighbour or shake hands with your acquaintance, you may opt for a set of different gestures: an elbow rub, an air kiss or a cruise tap (bumping two knuckles).

You are going to talk about avoiding physical closeness. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. Do you think that physical contact depends on nationalities? How does it work in your country of origin? Do you know about any other cultures?
- 2. How can society be affected by the absence of body contact for such a long time?

3. What advice would you give to people who are afraid of hugging or kissing their relatives?

INTERMITTENT FASTING

You have recently read an article about the benefits of the intermittent fasting diet, a diet in which you only eat for a certain number of hours, restricting the food intake to one or two meals per day with the intention of burning off fat.

- Come to an agreement and decide what you are going to do.

VIOLENT VIDEO GAMES

Studies provide converging evidence that exposure to media violence is a significant risk factor for aggressive and violent behaviour.

You are going to talk about violent video games. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. In your opinion, do you think videogames cause increased aggression?
- 2. Should videogames have stricter ratings or a stricter rating system?
- 3. Is there any benefit to playing videogames?

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- Come to an agreement and decide what you are going to do.

HOMEBUYING

According to several studies, fewer and fewer people opt for acquiring a property nowadays. The number of dwellings for rent has surpassed the average of homebuyers in countries like Germany or Finland.

You are going to talk about homebuying. Express your ideas and use arguments and examples to justify your opinion. Use the following questions as a help to prepare your monologue, but do not answer them directly:

- 1. What are the advantages and disadvantages of both renting and buying?
- 2. Are you a proprietor or a tenant? What could you recommend to first-time homebuyers?
- 3. What can the government do to increase the number of home sales?

- 1. Do you think sex education is necessary? Why? Why not?
- 2. Have you ever received such training? Is it typical in your country of origin?
- 3. What changes would you implement in the current education system concerning this issue?

You are going to talk about online learning for adults. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but do not answer them directly:

- 1. Do you think adult people can learn online?
- 2. What is the best approach for adults and in what specific fields?
- 3. Can adults keep on learning when they reach a certain age?

IT'S THE GOVERNMENT'S FAULT

People always blame everything on the government and make it responsible for the solution to every social issue. But what can you as an individual do to fix those problems? You are going to converse with your partner about the importance of individual's engagement in solving social issues. You are free to choose the subject but remember to give feedback about your partner's topics.

Make sure you meet the following requirements:

- Choose three social topics where people can help solve the problem. Explain why.
- Support your opinion. Give arguments and examples.
- React to your partner's topics and express your agreement or disagreement.

HEALTH AND PETS

"One day, it might be possible to 'prescribe' a dog for a young active child, a troubled adolescent or cardiovascular patient and know -as much as science can ever know- what the outcome is likely to be for their health."

Deliver a speech about online learning for adults. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. Are pets beneficial for our health? Why (not)? If so, how?
- 2. Do you think that the reality described byt the quote above is possible?
- 3. Would it be ethically and morally appropriate to use pets as objects or medicine? What are the implications about this hypothetical future or humans, for animals and their relationship?

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TARJETA 7A

RICH AND POOR

"Capitalism is the root cause of a global increase in living standards on a scale unprecedented in human history before the emergence of the market economy. Some people are myopically fixated on whether the rich are getting richer and whether the gap between rich and poor is widening because they are more driven by envy than by any honest sympathy for the fate of the poor."

Deliver a speech where you express your opinion about the quote above. Give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. Do you agree or disagree with what is stated in the quote? Why?
- 2. What could you do to fix the gap?
- 3. Do poor people deserve to be poor?

Make sure you meet the following requirements:

- Discuss about the best ways to promote reading in general. Express your concern. Support your arguments. Give examples.
- Express your agreement or disagreement with your partner's ideas for your relatives and friends.
- Suggest alternatives for your partner's own situation.

PLANNED OBSOLESCENCE

"It's widely held that certain gadgets, cars and other tech have deliberately short lifespans, to make you shell out to replace them. What's the reality? "They don't make 'em like they used to," as the idiom goes. So it would seem for the Centennial Light. An astonishing, record-setting 115 years after someone first flipped it on, this light bulb is still faintly shining in a fire station in Livermore, California."

Deliver a speech about planned obsolescence. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. What are the advantages of planned obsolescence for the economy? Give examples.
- 2. Do you think that planned obsolescence can be fixed?
- 3. What are the implications of planned obsolescence for the environment?

ALL-INCLUSIVE RESORTS

"In recent years, more and more hotels have chosen to provide all-inclusive tourist packages as a means of attracting new customers. A large number of tourists prefer to buy an all-inclusive package because it considers it to be cheaper, safer, and more efficient."

Deliver a speech about all-inclusive resorts. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. Do you think that all-inclusive resorts are cheaper, safer and more efficient? Why (not)?
- 2. What kind of people choose this type of holiday?
- 3. What is its impact on the local economy and environment?

SOCIAL NETWORKS AND 'MY REAL ME'

Social Networks such as Facebook, Instagram or Twitter may portray an image about people that might be fake. Why do you think this happens and what are the consequences for personal and work relationships? What is the impact on children? You are going to converse with your partner about this.

Make sure you meet the following requirements:

- Express your concerns about the given situations.
- Support your opinion. Give arguments and examples.
- React to your partner's concerns and express your agreement or disagreement with what (s)he says.

COMPLEMENTARY AND ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE

"Complementary and alternative medicines (CAMs) are treatments that fall outside of mainstream healthcare. Some complementary and alternative medicines or treatments are based on principles and an evidence base that are not recognised by the majority of independent scientists. The availability of CAMs on the NHS is limited, and in most cases the NHS will not offer such treatments."

Deliver a speech about CAMs. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. Are CAMs useful? Why (not)? If so, how?
- 2. What kind of people do you think use these methods? Why?
- 3. Should the NHS in your country cover the expenses of these treatments? Why (not)?

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TARJETA 9A TAREA DE PRODUCCIÓN

VEGANISM FOR CHILDREN

"A vegan diet is made up of only plant-based products — no meat, fish, dairy, or eggs (some people also exclude honey). While these diets are still relatively rare, they are becoming more common. If your family is not vegan and your child is asking to be, it's important to understand why. The reasons may be perfectly fine and healthy, but some children, especially teens, choose vegan diets in order to lose weight."

Deliver a speech about children becoming vegans. Express your opinion and give arguments to support your ideas. Use the following questions to help you guide your monologue but avoid answering them directly:

- 1. Are you concerned about children and teens becoming vegans? Why (not)?
- 2. What is your opinion about their change of mind regarding their diet habits?
- 3. Is veganism the solution for a more sustainable world when it comes to food consumption?

- Support your position by giving arguments and examples.
- React to your partner's ideas by expressing agreement or disagreement.

- 1. How important is your first impression for a date, a job interview, meeting new people...?
- 2. Can you change people's impression about you by changing the way you dress?
- 3. Up to what extent can a first impression become an ill strategy to relate to people?

- 1. In your opinion, should it be allowed to send plastic or rubbish overseas?
- 2. What can be done to reduce plastic waste? Propose some measures.
- 3. Are there any policies concerning plastic waste in your country? If so, talk about them.

- 2. What are the pros and cons of this practice?
- 3. What would you advise a person who wanted to start using these apps to do?

- 3. How can we achieve a mutually respectful society?
