#### **CRYPTO MUGGINGS**



- 2. Which are the roles associated with men and women? Have they changed in time?
- 3. How do you think these cultural messages could affect young boys and girls?

#### HUNTING





- 3. What are the impacts of sleep disorders in your everyday life?
