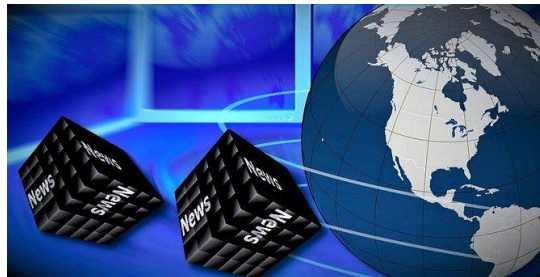
THE EVOLUTION OF RADIO BROADCASTING

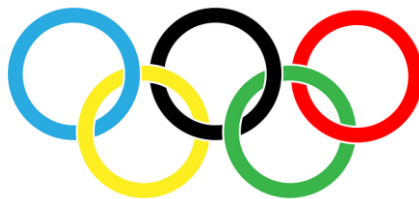

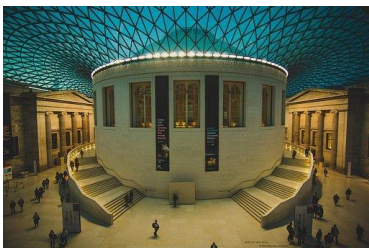
MUSEUMS

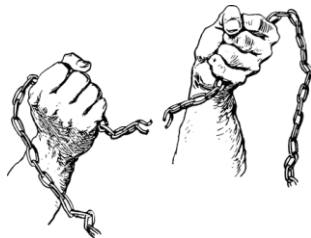
PRISON
