OPTION A – TEXTILE WASTE MANAGEMENT



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In modern consumer culture, we sometimes "shop until we drop," but we rarely think about the fate of our clothes when it comes time to clear out our wardrobes. How is this discarded clothing processed and where does it go? Does it have a purposeful second life? What can we do to generate less textile waste?

OPTION B - SPAIN'S CURRENT HOUSING CRISIS



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The traditional attachment to homeownership in Spain now clashes with a startling new reality: half of the single people in Spain have an average monthly income which makes it impossible for them to afford their own home. This is the conclusion reached by a study published on the financial portal HelpMyCash after comparing the net monthly salary of single people with the average cost of housing across all Spanish autonomous communities.
