TASK B. COPRODUCTION: FEEDBACK ON AIRBNB

You recently travelled to another city and booked an apartment through Airbnb. After your stay you wrote a neutral review, despite the fact that you were rather disappointed with a number of things (location, communication with host, tidiness, noise level, cold...). However, you find that the host has written the following bad review about you:

"I can't recommend (your name) as a guest. Upon arrival, she messaged me to ask where the beds were. I assumed she must have gone to the second-floor apartment instead, even though both our listing and my explicit check-in instructions are very clear that the apartment is on the first floor. I let her know that hers was the first-floor apartment. She messaged back to say "ok thanks.". That was the last time I heard from her.

During her stay, she again went into the recently vacated upstairs apartment, which is clearly off-limits to guests, turned the heat on upstairs to 28 degrees and left it on after departure, and left both that door wide open and the door to the building itself unlocked. Luckily, our home is in a safe neighbourhood; otherwise anyone could have walked in off the street. Had she sent a message, I would have addressed the situation immediately, but she gave me no chance to do so.

On top of that, apparently, she had a party in the apartment, when it's specifically forbidden in the house rules. To make matters worse, she left the rubbish bag in the bin so when I came in to have a look, the whole building was stinking of rotten food and I had a cohort of neighbours complaining."
